Dr. Seuss Enterprises (DSE) requires that Dr. Seuss costumed characters are used to promote Dr. Seuss books, literacy, and education programs. All costume requests must be submitted to DSE for review and approval. Costume characters cannot be used to support theme park events or events where alcohol is being served.

To ensure consideration, please fill in all appropriate entry fields on the following pages and provide as much detail as possible. Incomplete forms will not be reviewed.

If you are approved, you will receive a confirmation of your reservation from Costume Specialists within approximately three weeks. Please fill in your answers directly on this PDF and email the completed form to the appropriate contact.

PRICING

Customers are responsible for the shipping cost (approximately \$140-\$250, depending on the costume) and insurance for the costume. Customers are also responsible for any excessive wear or damage to the costume. Costume Specialists can advise on all costs associated with renting a costume.

PBS Requests: Any material promoting costume appearances must be submitted to DSE. DSE will permit the use of the following protected trademarks in connection with the event: show logo and show artwork, image of actual costume character (to be obtained through Costume Specialists), the term "Dr. Seuss" and the name of the costume character being rented ("The Cat in the Hat").
