- This costume is designed to be worn by someone of an average build and approximately 5'5" to 5'9" tall.
- The wearer ought to be of reasonable strength and stamina.
- T-shirt and shorts are best worn under the costume. It's advisable that the wearer drink plenty of liquids before and after the event.
- The costume must be worn WITH a pair of slipper or WITHOUT shoes.
- Be sure to have a dress rehearsal. It takes two people about 10 to 15 minutes to put on the costume. Becoming comfortable in the costume before the event will insure the best performance.

For the safety of small children and others it is suggested that the performer has an assistant to help guide her/him.



Parade Feet

Wearing Instructions For **Eagle**



1 Put on the Legs.
Pull the top just above the knee. The bottom should stop at the wearers ankles



2 Put on the Body.
Zip closed in the back and velcro closed at the neck.

Located in the Wings are opening that are velcroed shut. Open the velcro to free the wearer's hands when needed.



3 Put on the Feet.
Step into the Foot and velcro closed in the back.



4 Put on the Head.
The Head should rest on the wearers shoulders.



5 Put on the Gloves.



6 The Eagle is now ready to entertain.
