PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE DRESSING THE WEARER!

- ☐ This costume is designed to be worn by someone of an average build, reasonable stamina and strength. The wearer should be approximately 5'6" to 5'10" tall.
- ☐ The costume must be worn **WITHOUT** shoes. T-shirt and shorts are best worn under the costume. It's advisable that the wearer drink plenty of liquids before and after the event.
- ☐ Make sure the Fan works. Locate the bright fabric covering the switch inside the head; press the **RED** button to switch the fan **ON** and **OFF**. If the fan doesn't start lift the fabric and install a new 9volt battery. **NOTE:** Due to the current **COVID 19** pandemic and to stop the further spread of the virus, we recommend all costume performers wear a **FACE MASK** and the **COOLING FAN ONLY** be operated after installing a **SAFETY FILTER**. **BE SURE TO TURN OFF THE FAN AFTER YOUR EVENT!**

- ☐ Be sure to have a dress rehearsal. It takes two people about 10 to 15 minutes to put on the costume. Becoming comfortable in the costume before the event will ensure the best performance.
- ☐ **NO** drinking, eating or smoking in costume. **HAVE FUN!**

Character Etiquettes

Do's:

- Watch out for small children. Get eye level to children.
- Wave hello or good-bye when walking to or from a person.
- Keep a consistent level of energy.

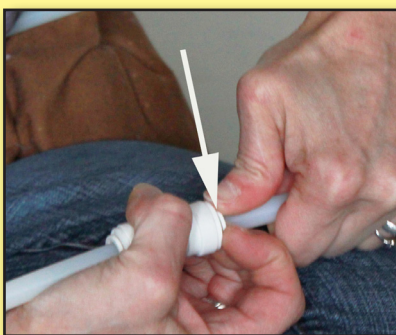
Don'ts:

- Smoking, eating or drinking while in costume.
- Dragging your feet.
- Never show frustration; remember body language is readable in costume.
- Touch a person in an inappropriate area of the body. Remember your gloves maybe bigger than your hands and may extend into an area of the body that your hand would not.
- Lean on the head of a child.
- Put your gloves in the face of any person.
- Lay down in costume.
- Never let the public see you without your head on.
- Wear the costume for more than 30 – 45 minutes at a time without a break.

NOTE:

Due to the current **COVID 19** pandemic and to stop the further spread of the virus, we recommend ALL Costume Performers wear a **FACE MASK** and the Cooling Fan **ONLY** be operated after installing a **SAFETY FILTER**. The Safety Filter must be changed **before each Event or between Performers!** Please wear **GLOVES** when handling the Filters! **Be sure to turn OFF the Fan and REMOVE the Filter after your Event!** **SAFETY FILTERS** and **PPE EVENT KITS** are available at

Hoop Removal

To open the Pod Hoops, hold the Hoop on either side of the Connector. With one thumb, push the outer most ring toward the center of the Connector. With the other hand, hold it there. This will release the Hoop and it can be pulled free of the connector.

Notice

It is crucial that the Head, Body, Parts and any clothing be completely **DRY** before it is worn or **STORED!**

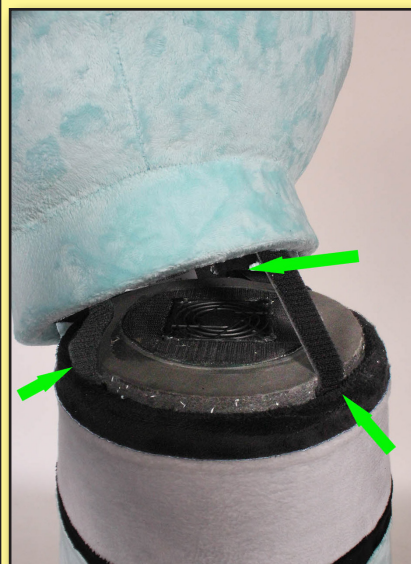

1 Installing Filter:
Please wear **GLOVES** when handling the Fan Filter! Remove the plastic and locate the Fan inside the Head. Secure the **CF** Filter to the Velcro around the Fan as pictured.

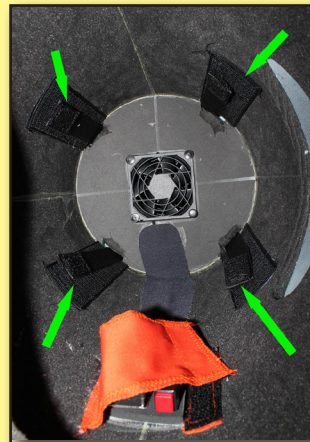
The Fan Filter must be **REPLACED BEFORE** each Event or **BETWEEN** performers!
STAY SAFE!



2 Attach the Head to the Harness. Guide the four Velcro straps through the openings in the Neck as pictured.



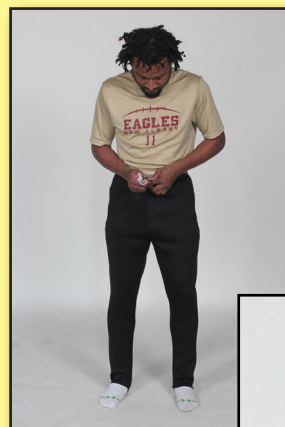
3 Make sure the Head is sitting on the Harness/Neck even. The base of the Head should be over the foam lip of the fan base.



4 Reach inside the Head and secure the Velcro straps in place. The Head should be snug on the Neck, no gaps!



5 Load the Pod into the Body Cover. Make sure the armholes, legholes and zippers line up.



6 Put on the Pants! Tighten the string at the waist and tuck it in the Pants. Make sure the wearer's feet are in the stirrups before the Feet are put on. This will help keep the legs in place. The Stirrup can be pulled free from the inside of the Legs and readjusted for comfort.

7 Now put on the loaded Pod and Body Cover. Hold it up at your waist until the Head and Feet are put on.



8 Put on the Feet. Secure the wearer's feet in the Velcro harness on the Shoe Base.



9 Attach the Covers to Shoe Bases by placing the toes to the velcro on the front of the Base. Continue placing the Velcro around the Bases. Secure the Velcro flap in the back of the Shoe Covers.



10 Locate the bright fabric inside the Harness. Press the Red button to turn the Cooling Fan ON and OFF. If the fan doesn't start lift the fabric and install a new 9volt battery.

Make sure the Fan is OFF and REMOVE the Filter after the EVENT!



11 Put on the Head. Clip the shoulder straps under the arms. Now the Body and Pod can be pulled up and zipped closed in the back.



12 Now, pull the Pod and Body up. Zip the Pod closed Velcro the back of the Body to the Pod. Then zip the Body closed!

13 Pigeon is now ready to entertain! HAVE FUN! If needed the wearer's hands can be freed!



14 Please remove the Head from the Neck before packing!



15 Leave the Pod in the Body. Fold the arms and upper body down into itself.



16 Put the Pod and Body in the bottom of the trunk first. Place the Feet and Legs in the corners as pictured.



17 Clip the clips closed on the Harness. Place the Head in the trunk face down in the Body & Pod. Lay the Neck along side it as pictured.



18 Place the lid and secure the straps!
